How to Transfer Contacts to your basic Phones.

iPhone:

Option 1:

- 1. On your old iPhone open your App store and download "Contact Cleanup"
- 2. Follow steps to make a full backup of all contacts.
- 3. E-mail the contacts to yourself.
- 4. Download the email file it should be an attachment that ends in .VCF
- 5. Bluetooth or copy to your new device.

Option 2:

- 1. Make sure ALL your contacts are backed-up to the iCloud.
- 2. Login into your iCloud account from a Computer. Go to icloud.com use your apple ID and Password that you would use on your iPhone.
- 3. Select the "contacts" icon, then click the "Gear" icon in the bottom left corner, and select the "Select All" option THEN click "export vcard".
- 4. Connect your basic phone to your computer and copy the downloaded file to it.
- 5. Depending on your device, use the import contacts function in the contact app or open the copied file from the file manager app. Follow prompts and you should have all your contacts.

Option 3:

- 1. Make sure ALL your contacts are backed-up to your Google account (or Gmail account).
- 2. Login into your Google account from a Computer. Go to contacts.google.com use your Gmail email and Password that you would use on your Smartphone.
- 3. Select the export item from the left side menu, (You may need to open that menu up by clicking on the 3-line icon on the top left.) and click the blue Export button.
- 4. Connect your basic phone to your computer and copy the downloaded file to it.
- 5. Depending on your device, use the import contacts function in the contact app or open the copied file from the file manager app. Follow prompts and you should have all your contacts.

Android

Option 1:

- 1. Open the google contacts app. (If it does not come on your device by default, download it form the app store.)
- 2. Open the menu in the app click settings then find and select "export". Name the export file something like Contacts, and make note of the location on your device the file is being saved to.
- 3. Pair your smartphone and your basic phone using Bluetooth, following the prompts and both devices.
- 4. Find your saved contacts file, select the file and find the share option click the Bluetooth item and select your basic phone that you paired. You will be prompted to allow the transfer from your basic

Option 2:

- 1. Make sure ALL your contacts are backed-up to your Google account (or Gmail account).
- 2. Login into your Google account account from a Computer. Go to contacts.google.com use your Gmail email and Password that you would use on your Smartphone.
- 3. Select the export item from the left side menu, (You may need to open that menu up by clicking on the 3-line icon on the top left.) and click the blue Export button.

PART 4

Setup E-mail on your basic phone:

Most e-mail providers do not support basic phones anymore. These are some of the workarounds to make it possible.

Gmail:

We need to configure your email to allow your basic phone email app.

- 1. Login to myaccounts.google.com/apppasswords from a computer. Use your Gmail email address and password.
- 2. Follow prompts to generate a new app password.
- 3. On your basic phone, follow prompts to setup your email manually. Sometimes you need to put the password (not your regular email password use your new app password from step 2

AOL:

- 1. Sign in to your AOL Account Security page.
- 2. Click Generate app password or Generate and manage app passwords.
- 3. Enter your app's name in the text field.
- 4. Click Generate password.
- 5. Follow the instructions below the password.
- Be sure to enter the password into your app without any spaces. Click Done.
- 6. Use this app password and your email address to sign in to your email app

Yahoo:

- 1. Login in to your yahoo account by going to login.yahoo.com/myaccount select manage account>account security.
- 2. Click Generate app password or Generate and manage app passwords.
- 3. Enter your app's name in the text field.
- 4. Click Generate password.
- 5. Follow the instructions below the app password.
- 6. Click Done.
- 7. Use the app password that you just generated and your email address to sign in to your email app.
