

iOS Screen Time Tutorial

This is a tutorial on how to set up screen time on your Apple device (eg. iPhone, iPad, iPod, and some limited functions on a Mac)

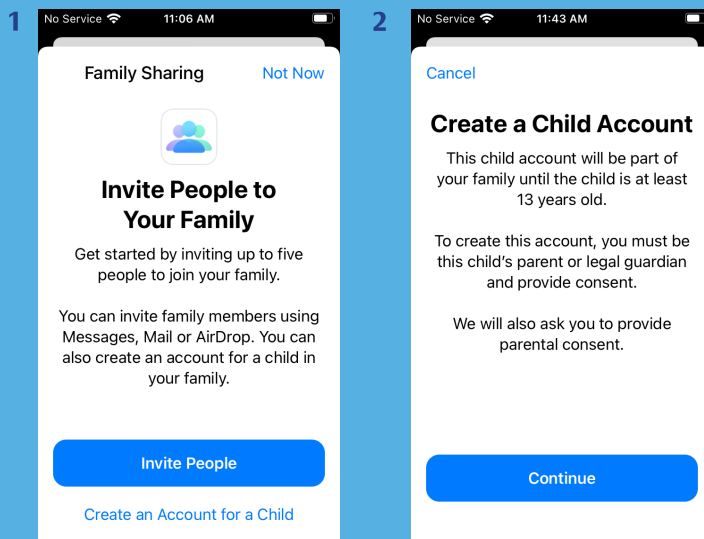
Before you start make sure you are connected to the internet via LTE or Wifi
Make sure you have/know your Apple ID and password (click here to create one)

Manage a child's screen time on the parents device remotely:

Start on Parents Device go to:

- Settings
- Click on your name
- Click family sharing¹

Either use child's Apple ID or create a new Apple ID



Make sure the age is set between 9yr – 11yr²

If you are using the child's Apple ID then click INVITE:

Invite people (send link to device)

- Email
- Text
- Airdrop

If you are not using child's Apple ID then sign out and create a new Apple ID



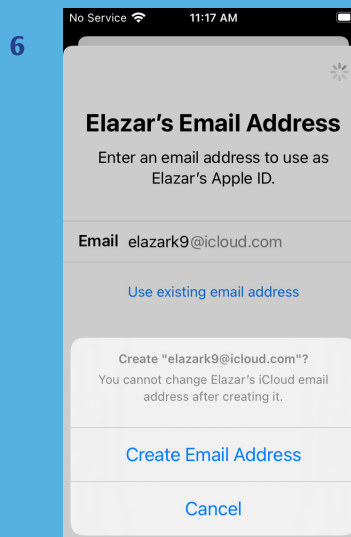
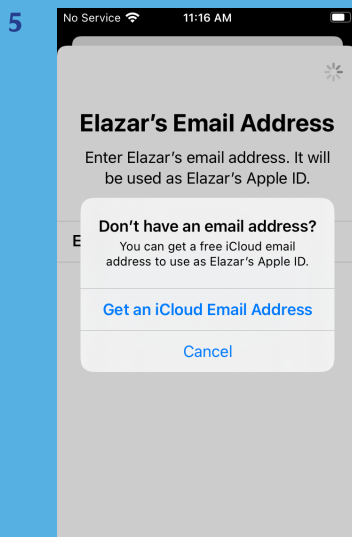
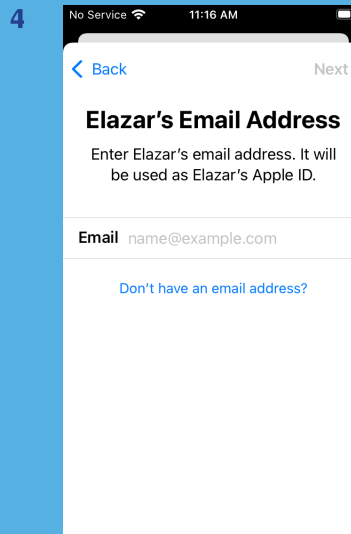
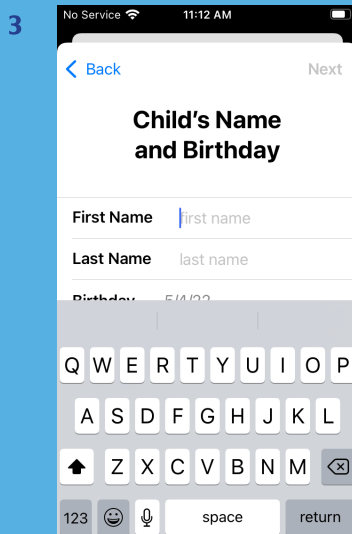
Create an account for a Child

- Add Family Member
- Accept Terms and Conditions – Continue
- Fill out the parent consent
- Fill in child's name
- Fill in child's birthday (make them between the age of 9yr – 11yr.

Once they turn 13 you won't be able to fully manage their device)³

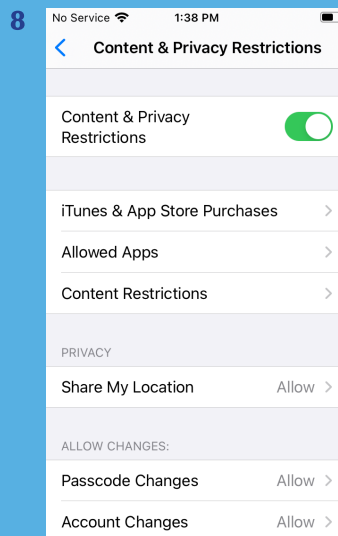
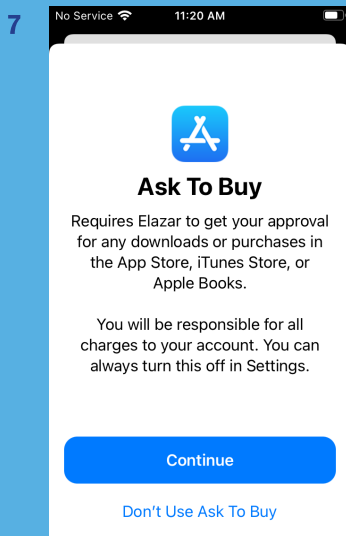
If you have an email, fill it in or click don't have an email address⁴

- Click get an icloud email address^{5 & 6}
- Click create email address



- Create password
- Use a phone number
- Ask to buy – click continue⁷
- Click Share location
- Now go to the child’s device – sign in with the new icloud account.
- On the parent’s device – Go to settings and tap screen time
- By family – click on the child’s name you wish to restrict
- Turn on screen time
- Downtime click not now (you can turn on later see notes)
- App limits click not now (you can turn on later see notes)
- Content and privacy continue
- Continue from step 3 below

Manage screentime on child’s device not remotely:



1. Go to Settings and tap Screen Time.
2. Tap Continue, then choose “This is My Child’s Device”
3. Tap Use Screen Time Passcode to create a passcode, then re-enter the passcode to confirm.
4. If prompted put in your Apple ID and Password
5. Turn off share across devices
6. Tap Content & Privacy Restrictions
7. Top right corner enable the restrictions⁸

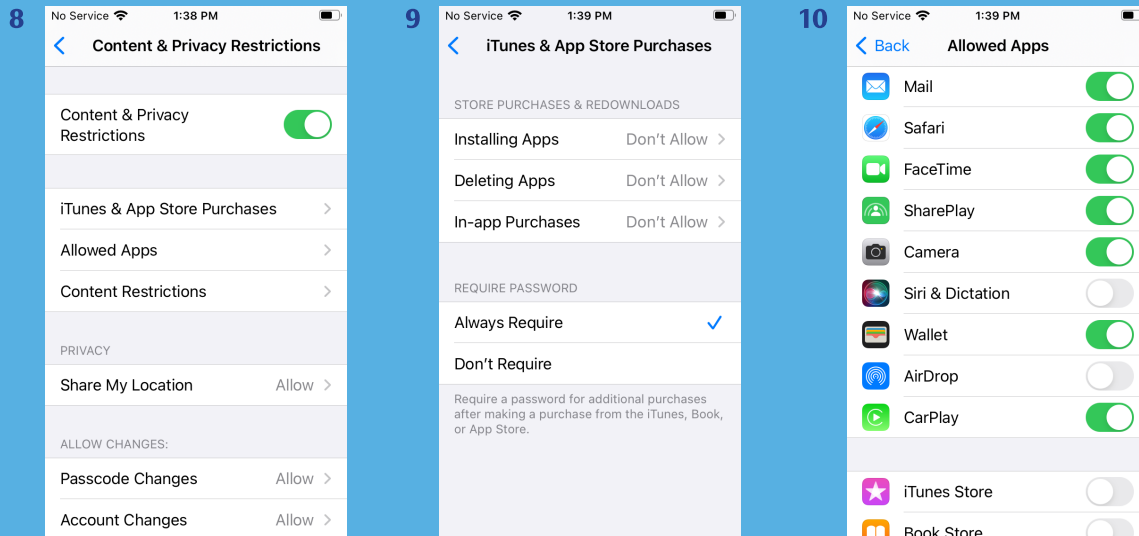


Lets only Focus on three tabs.

iTunes & App Store Purchases⁹

- **Installing Apps - Don't Allow - will remove the app store from the screen - see notes**
- **Deleting Apps - Don't Allow - will disable the ability of deleting apps**
- **In-app Purchases Apps - Don't Allow - certain apps will not be able to be downloaded**
- **Required Password - Always require.**

Hit the back arrow

Allowed Apps¹⁰

- **Safari - Leave Open (see below allow websites only)**
- **Siri & Dictation - Turn Off**
- **AirDrop - Turn Off**
- **iTunes store - Turn Off**
- **Book Store - Turn Off**
- **Podcast - Turn Off**
- **News - Turn Off**
- **Health - Turn Off**

Even if you want no access to safari, however some apps need a url to function properly. When the app stops working it will send you to safari to add the url which you then will put in the password to allow it. Verify the url before hitting Allow Website.



Hit the back arrow

Content Restrictions¹¹

- Music, Podcasts, News, & Workouts – Clean
- Music videos from – Off
- Music profiles from – Off
- Movies – Choose an appropriate rating
- TV Shows – Choose an appropriate rating
- Books – Clean
- Apps – 9+ will remove social media, entertainment apps. See notes
- App Clips – Don't Allow

Web Content¹²

Be most cautious when deciding which tab you choose.

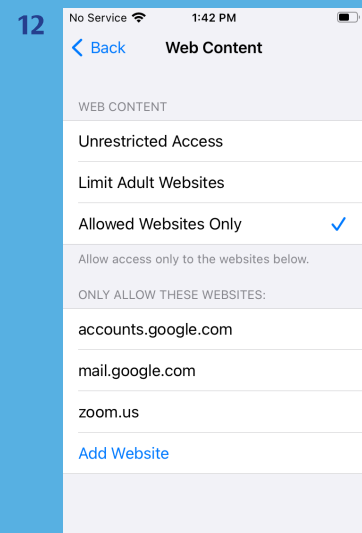
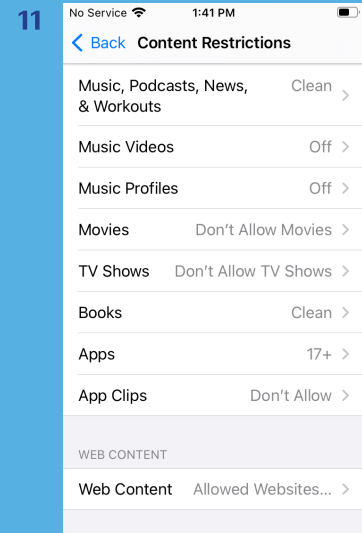
- Unrestricted Access
- Limit Adult Websites
- Allowed Websites Only

Unrestricted Access

Gives unfiltered access to search safari

Limit Adult Websites

- Removes the known adult websites
- Allows access to Entertainment, Gambling, and Social Media
- This is not fool-proof in blocking out “Adult” sites. There are a lot of sites that are not in any category, and some that Apple mislabels.

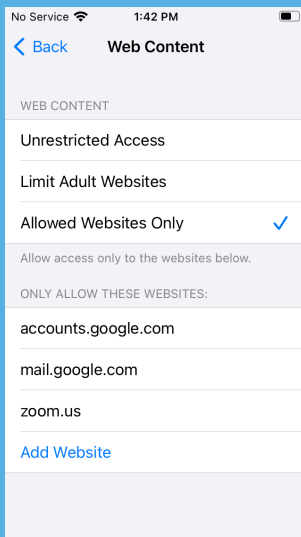


Allowed Websites Only

Our # 1 recommendation for children¹³

- This will block any website not added to the allow list
- Slide the preloaded sites to the left and remove them from you list
- Some apps won't work if you don't add the URLs here e.g. nfl.com, nba.com
- You can add the URL's in safari to by typing the exact URL and then hit allow

We suggest adding the following websites for basic usage of the device:

Accounts.google.com, Mail.google.com, Zoom.us

Be cautious: if you type in the wrong url, safari will send you to to google.com. If you allow it, then the main google search engine will be enabled, including the image tab.

Siri

- Web Search Content - Don't Allow
- Explicit Language - Don't Allow

Game Center¹⁴

- Multiplayer Games from – allow friends only
- Adding Friends – Don't Allow
- Connect with Friends only
- Screen Recording – Don't Allow
- Nearby Multiplayer – Don't Allow
- Private Messaging – Don't Allow
- Profile Privacy Changes – Don't Allow
- Avatar & Nickname Changes – Don't Allow

Hit the back arrow

Allow Changes – Recommended

- Passcode Changes – Don't Allow
- Account changes – Don't Allow

Passcode code – will not allow the child to change the passcode to open the device

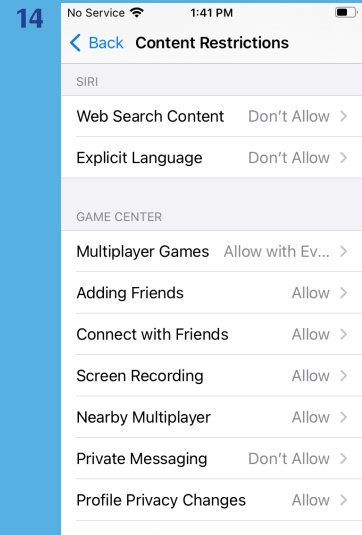
Account change will not allow the child to change the Apple ID password

Notes:

★ The app store has app icons, app descriptions and reviews that are searchable and can be inappropriate. The best practice would be to keep the app store closed and when a child needs an app you can open the store, download the app and then close the store.

★ If you decide to keep the store open, either rate it or have your child ask you to approve the app either by you putting the Apple ID or a message is sent to your iPhone and hit approved.

Downtime¹⁵



Scheduled – Enable it
Every Day is set by default
Choose the time the Internet will be disabled

App Limit¹⁶

- **Add limit**
- **Choose the All Apps or just a category or specific apps**
- **Next**
- **Choose the lotted time for the app to be in use a day**
- **Add**
- **We found that a child can override this by clicking one minute**

Always Allowed¹⁷

- **Apps you want the child to access all the time, like phone or calculator can added to the above list by hitting the plus sign near it.**
- **These Allowed Apps will be allowed even during Downtime**
